**REORGANIZING THE LOCAL COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF
CHILDREN MUNICIPAL INTER-AGENCY MONITORING TASK FORCE
(LCPC-MIMTF)**

WHEREAS, Articles 359 and 360 of the Civil Code of the Philippines provide that the government shall establish Councils for the Protection of Children, taking into account that children are the ones who are most vulnerable to abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation, among others;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9344, as amended by RA 10630, otherwise known as the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006, in turn reiterates the mandate of Local Government Units to establish their respective LCPC and to allocate at least 1% of their Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) for its strengthening;

WHEREAS, throughout the years, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) has issued several memorandum circulars to guide Local Government Units (LGUs) to establish their respective Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPCs) pursuant to Republic Act Nos. 4881 and 8980 and Presidential Decree No. 603, as amended;

WHEREAS, to sustain national efforts in localization of the National Strategic Framework for Plan Development for Children or Child 21, there is a need to make LCPCs functional as the core local institution for child-related programs;

WHEREAS, the LCPC shall be the main conduit through which local stakeholders, including child-focused institutions and non-government organizations and people's and youth organizations, are consulted, and their meaningful participation is ensured in the planning and implementation of intervention and programs for children.

NOW, THEREFORE, HON. JONAN D. TABANDA, Municipal Mayor of San Vicente, Ilocos Sur, by virtue of the powers vested in me by laws, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The Local Council for the Protection of Children Municipal Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force (LCPC - MIMTF) is hereby organized, to be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The MIMTF shall discharge the following duties and responsibilities:

- a) Retrieve required documents from BCPC;
- b) Review submitted documents;
- c) Evaluate/assess the BCPCs based on the documents submitted or conduct actual field monitoring/ table validation, whichever is more feasible;
- d) Meet with the concerned barangay official for feedback on the strengths and weaknesses of the council;
- e) Submit required forms and report to the Provincial IMTF copy furnished to the DILG Municipal Operations Office; and,
- f) Meet regularly together with the MCPC to discuss issues and resolve problems concerning children.

SECTION 3. FUNDING. The Municipal Government shall allocate the necessary funding requirements for the operation of the MIMTF.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
